Property Revaluation Postponed

In light of the significant impact caused by Helene, Haywood County has announced a two-year postponement of its countywide property revaluation process. The revaluation, originally scheduled for 2025, will now take place on **January 1, 2027**.

Debris Progress

As of today 7,351 cubic yards of debris have been picked up from locations across Haywood County.

This is the equivalent of 21 tons or enough to fill more than 2 Olympic Swimming Pools.

Baptists on Mission: Helene Rebuilding

11/1/2024: Baptists on Mission is responding in the aftermath of Hurricane Helene in the mountains of western North Carolina. We've set up large feeding and recovery (mud out, tear out, chainsaw, etc.) operations in 14 locations in Western North Carolina.

Volunteers are helping with feeding; shower and laundry; chain saw teams; tarping roofs; mudding and tearing out homes; and more. You don't need to be trained to serve with some of these opportunities.

We are starting the first rebuild phase. In this first phase we are trying to get people back into their home and make it safe, sanitary and functional (not finished) before the worst of winter. Volunteers will be needed for the next few years to help people finish their homes.
