At the regular Called Meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen/women of the Town of Canton held at 85 Summer Street, Canton NC, July 11, 2026, at 6:00 pm with Mayor Smathers and Aldermen/women Hamlett, Mull, Shepherd and Proctor present the following proceedings were held.

A. Call to Order

Mayor Smathers called the meeting to order at 6:03 pm

B. Roll Call

Mayor Smathers stated that Manager Stinnett, Assistant Manager Walker and Town Attorney Morgan were present. Deputy Clerk Young was absent.

C. Pledge

Alderman Hamlett led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

D. Approval of Minutes: June 25, 2026

Alderwoman Mull made a motion to approve the June 25, 2026, minutes as presented.

Alderwoman Proctor seconded the motion. All members voted in favor of the motion.

E. Mayor Comments

Mayor Smathers thanked the Town employees for their work on the July 4th Plus One event; there was a great turnout. Mayor Smathers thanked Champion Credit Union for the fireworks. Mayor Smathers stated he has a meeting scheduled with the Department of Transportation about the lines on Academy Street. Manager Stinnett stated the Stormwater Project will help.

F. Aldermen/women Comments

Alderwoman Mull stated the turnout for the employee picnic and the decorations for July 4th Plus One were great. Alderman Hamlett thanked the Mountaineer for an article about a woman who fell in her bathtub. We are nearing winter and people need to be reminded to check on others. Alderwoman Proctor stated she has received three positive messages about the Rec Park and there are TikToks being made in support. Alderman Shepherd thanked the staff for their work on the July 4th Plus One event.

G. Public Comments

Jed Godfrey and Roland Rhodes from Candler asked about historical license plates. Plates that used to be active. He would like to purchase them if the Town could sell them. Enka sells them for \$20.

Carl Cortwright stated that he appreciated the “Yard Ninjas”, they do an excellent job.
